## **Regents to Announce Efforts to Increase Attainment**

BATON ROUGE, La. – The Board of Regents will announce plans for increasing the attainment of students attending Louisiana's colleges and universities during its board development meeting beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, August 26, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board Conference Room located on the 6<sup>th</sup> floor of the Claiborne Building, 1201 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

Dr. Stan Jones, former Commissioner of Higher Education and state legislator from Indiana, will present data indicating that the United States and Louisiana need higher educational attainment at all levels in postsecondary education. Dr. Jones is currently the Director of the National Council on College Completion for the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

Following Dr. Jones' presentation, Ali Mir, representing Sir Michael Barber and McKinsey and Company's Global Education Practice, along with Commissioner of Higher Education Sally Clausen will announce a partnership with McKinsey's Education Delivery Institute. The delivery institute will focus on assisting Louisiana in meeting its target goal of graduating 10,000 additional students by the year 2015.
