The West Baton Rouge Conference and Visitors Center is located close to I-10. Take Exit 151 (US 190/Lobdell). Soon after exiting I-10 onto LA 415, turn right onto Commercial Drive and take the first right onto North Westport Drive. The center can be seen from I-10. It will be important for all 8 PARCC Campus Leadership Team members to attend the statewide meeting. Doug Sovde from the national PARCC office will meet with the team members during the morning to provide more in-depth information pertaining to the Common Core State Standards and the development of the new PARCC assessments. Team members will have an opportunity to interact with team members from their universities and other universities on

issues that are relevant to K-12 and higher education. Time will also be spent discussing the roles of the PARCC Campus Leadership Team members on each campus. For your information, I have attached an overview of the state infrastructure for PARCC and a description of your roles and responsibilities.

You need to be aware that chancellors/presidents from all public and private universities in Louisiana were invited to send a team of four key campus leaders (e.g., chancellor/president, chief academic officer, college of arts/sciences/humanities dean, and college of education dean) to participate in a PARCC Leadership Summit on August 30, 2011. The key campus leaders were provided an orientation by national PARCC leaders about the Common Core State Standards and the PARCC assessments. In addition, the roles of campus leaders in the development and use of the Common Core State Standards and PARCC assessments were discussed from a state perspective. The chancellors/presidents were made aware of the existence of the PARCC Campus Leadership Teams and provided a listing of your names. They are aware that you will be helping to disseminate information to campus faculty about the Common Core State Standards and PARCC assessments and you will help to attain input from faculty that will be communicated to state and national PARCC leaders. They left the summit with the realization that many changes will be occurring during the next four years that will directly impact their campuses.
